## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF YEAR 2005 CoED AWARDS/PRIZES**

### **THE HARDEN-SIMONS PRIZE**

The HARDEN-SIMONS PRIZE is an annual award for the outstanding *Computers in Education Journal* paper on computational methods and is to commemorate the unselfish contributions of Drs. Harden and Simons to CoED. The HARDEN-SIMONS PRIZE for year 2005 consists of a Certificate and a cash award of \$400. All papers published in the *Computers in Education Journal* in 2005 are eligible for the HARDEN-SIMONS PRIZE and notice of this prize was first published in the November - December 1983 issue of the *Journal*.

### **THE MERL K. MILLER AWARD**

The MERL K. MILLER AWARD is an annual prize for the outstanding *Computers in Education Journal* paper on teaching/instructional methods and is to commemorate the contributions and dedication of Merl K. Miller to CoED. The MERL K. MILLER AWARD for year 2005 consists of a Certificate and a cash prize of \$400. All papers published in the *Computers in Education Journal* in 2005 are eligible for the MERL K. MILLER AWARD and notice of this Award was first published in the November – December 1983 issue of the *Journal*.

### **THE RAY H. SPIESS AWARD**

The RAY H. SPIESS AWARD is an annual prize for the outstanding *Computers in Education Journal* paper on hybrid analog/digital computers/computation and is to commemorate the contributions of Ray H. Spiess and Comdyna, Inc., to the development of CoED. The RAY H. SPIESS AWARD for 2005 consists of a Certificate and a cash prize of \$400. All papers published in the *Computers in Education Journal* in 2005 are eligible for the RAY H. SPIESS AWARD and notice of this Award was first published in the October – December 1984 issue of the *Journal*.

### **THE EAI AWARD**

The EAI AWARD is an annual prize for the outstanding *Computers in Education Journal* paper on analog computers/computation and is to commemorate the contributions of EAI, ( Electronic Associates, Inc.) to the development of CoED. The EAI AWARD for year 2005 consists of a Certificate and a cash prize of \$400. All papers published in the *Computers in Education Journal* in 2005 are eligible for the EAI AWARD and notice of this CoED Award was first published in the January – February 1984 issue of the *Journal*.

### **JOHN A. CURTIS LECTURE AWARD**

The JOHN A. CURTIS LECTURE AWARD was established by CoED in 1974 as a prize for the best paper presented at the CoED sessions of the ASEE Annual Conference. The year 2005 award consists of a Certificate and a cash prize of \$300.

### **WOODY EVERETT AWARD**

The WOODY EVERETT AWARD was established by CoED in 1988 for the best paper/presentation/demonstration at the CoED Poster Session of the ASEE Annual Meeting. The year 2005 award consists of a Certificate and a cash prize of \$300.
